

## PRESSING OUALITY AND ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

PRESSING, S.A, company dedicated to integral printing services on different bases and finishings, defines in its management policy its commitment to quality and environment. The policy is based on the following aspects:

- Satisfaction of stakeholders in the printing services, offering high-quality and environmentally friendly work that meets their needs while optimizing response time.
- **Risk assessment and prevention** to minimize errors that may affect the service provided, as well as commitment to environmental protection and pollution prevention.
- Compliance with safety and health standards by implementing work procedures that ensure
  printed products are handled, stored, and transported safely to prevent physical harm or exposure
  to hazardous substances, and by using materials and products free from toxic or harmful
  substances, as well as inks and additives that meet environmental safety standards.
- Continuous improvement of processes, services, and of the environmental impact of activities
  with the involvement of the organization's personnel and suppliers. Establishment of long-term
  objectives and goals with regular reviews to identify areas for improvement, as well as opportunities
  for innovation and environmental impact reduction.
- Optimization of energy consumption through the use of energy-efficient equipment and efficient usage practices.
- **Reduction of greenhouse gas emissions** and other air pollutants associated with operations by promoting the use of renewable energy, the installation of solar panels, a more sustainable transportation fleet, prioritizing non-polluting inks, and responsible waste management.
- **Sustainable water management** by monitoring its consumption (primarily for domestic use), implementing measures to reduce it with specific objectives, identifying opportunities for improvement, and promoting sustainable practices such as installing water-saving devices or immediately repairing leaks.
- Responsible management of hazardous and non-hazardous waste in accordance with
  environmental regulations by properly segregating and disposing of waste, prioritizing recycling and
  reuse, and adopting practices that minimize waste generation, such as efficient use of paper and
  reduction of unnecessary packaging.

- Sustainable management of raw materials by prioritizing the use of non-polluting inks with lower environmental impact and paper from managed forests that respect ecological and social values, as well as responsible forest management. In general, promoting the use of more environmentally friendly products and reducing the use of raw materials.
- **Responsible and safe use of chemicals** in all printing processes. Staff training on their handling and storage, as well as on necessary safety measures to prevent incidents. Process optimization by promoting innovation with more sustainable products and reducing their consumption. Printing techniques that minimize the use of resources and the environmental impact.
- **Promotion of sustainable consumption** by offering a range of products that use recyclable and recycled materials (such as recycled or FSC/PEFC-certified paper) and are produced with printing techniques that minimize resource use and environmental impact. Promoting collaboration with sustainable suppliers as well as designing products that are easier to recycle or reuse at the end of their life, facilitating disassembly and material separation, and reducing non-recyclable components.
- **Education and awareness**: Raising awareness among staff about the importance of sustainability by providing tools and knowledge to implement sustainable practices in their daily work. Training programs on the proper use of materials and equipment, safe work practices, handling chemicals, and using machinery. Training on how to correctly separate and classify waste. Promoting employee participation in environmental improvement initiatives.
- **Compliance with all legal and regulatory requirements** affecting activities and services in the different areas of its management, and with all applicable environmental regulations related to printing and waste management. Active search for improvement opportunities beyond the minimum legal requirements.
